

Northern Sacramento Valley Integrated Regional Water Management Technical Advisory Committee

Tehama Landowner Representative Solicitation

The Tehama County Flood Control and Water Conservation District Board is soliciting interested individuals to serve as their representative on the Northern Sacramento Valley Integrated Regional Water Management (NSVIRWM) Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) as a "Tehama County landowner" appointment due to the resignation of the previous appointee. The NSVIRWM area includes all of Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Sutter and Tehama Counties and a portion of Shasta County. The TAC includes landowners and county-level staff representatives from each of the six counties that were appointed by each county's Board of Supervisors. The TAC also includes one representative from the State Department of Water Resources (DWR), one representative from the Northern California Water Association (NCWA), and three "at-large" public interest representatives from within the region. The at-large appointments are made by the NSVIRWM Board. Public interest representation may include, but not be necessarily limited to: agricultural water use, environmental resources, recreation, domestic well use, municipal well use or tribal interests.

The TAC meets twice quarterly and is a working group that advises the Board and acts as staff to the Board. The Board directs the activities of the TAC. Appointments to the TAC will be reconsidered every two years or as positions are vacated.

Individuals wishing to be considered for the Tehama County landowner appointment shall reside in the county and be prepared to travel within the region, though TAC meetings are typically held in Willows. Candidates will need to commit to serving on the TAC for two years and have a general understanding of water resources and of the NSV region. Interested individuals should submit a resume and cover letter (three pages maximum) explaining the facet of public interest they wish to represent and why they should be selected to serve on the TAC.
