

**TEHAMA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT  
AB3030 GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN  
TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
NOVEMBER 14, 2011**

1. **CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order at 2:00 by Chairman Dean Sherrill.
2. **INTRODUCTIONS:** Self-introductions by all in attendance.
3. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** Allan Fulton announced the “Local Management of Water Resources in the Northern Sacramento Valley” meeting, being held December 16, 2011 at the Corning Veteran’s Hall.  
  
Gary Antone informed the committee of the “Water Knowledge Workshop”, hosted by West Yost, held in Davis. Allan Fulton and Stan Wangberg also attended.
4. **APPROVAL OF AUGUST 29, 2011 MINUTES:** Motion by Walt Mansell, second by Stan Wangberg to approve the August 29, 2011 minutes. Motion carried 7-0 with 3 absent.
5. **APPROVE 2012 MEETING DATES:** TAC member have previously agreed to meet on a quarterly basis. The proposed meeting dates are February 27, May 14, August 13 and November 19, 2012. Motion by Walt Mansell, second by Ryan Sale to approve the proposed meeting dates. Motion carried 7-0 with 3 absent.
6. **CALL FOR NOMINATIONS:** This item was marked as informational and will be carried over to the February 2012 meeting.
7. **CASGEM REPORT:** Judy Brown informed the TAC that Tehama County’s current plan meets DWR’s CASGEM requirement, and that all key wells set by Tehama County will serve as CASGEM wells. The CASGEM report is available via email, as well as on the CASGEM website.
8. **RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF REVISED LIST OF KEY WELLS FOR AB3030 PLAN:** Judy Brown distributed spreadsheet titled ‘2011 Proposed Key Wells & Trigger Levels’, which highlights wells that are not currently considered key wells. It is Judy’s recommendation that the TAC adopt the proposed wells as key wells.

Ryan Sale expressed an interest in seeing the impacts to wells with the loss of Lake Red Bluff. Judy will present a chart with the most current data at the February 2012 meeting.

Seth Lawrence of DWR informed the TAC that any problems resulting from the loss of Lake Red Bluff will be seen in August 2012.

Motion by Ryan Sale, second by Allan Fulton to adopt the new key wells. Motion carried 7-0 with 3 absent.

9. **RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF REVISED 2011 TRIGGER LEVELS FOR KEY WELLS:** Judy Brown presented this information as a follow-up to discussion at a previous meeting. The trigger levels have been rounded to whole numbers to line up with the Technical Memorandums. Additionally the trigger levels would be renamed to 'Spring and Fall'.

Motion by Allan Fulton, second by Ryan Sale to make the proposed changes to the Trigger Levels for key wells. Motion carried 7-0 with 3 absent.

10. **APPROVE OUTREACH LETTER TO LANDOWNERS FOR SUBMITTAL TO FLOOD CONTROL BOARD:** Judy Brown presented a draft letter to landowners regarding the Tehama County AB3030 Groundwater Management Plan. Additionally, the letter provides links to resources for landowners.

This letter will be revised and presented at the February 27, 2012 meeting.

11. **UPDATE ON TEHAMA COUNTY GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN:** Allan Fulton distributed the most recent version of the Tehama County AB3030 Groundwater Management Plan for review. The deadline for comments is December 16, 2011.
