CONSTRUCTABILITY REVIEW FOR JELLYS FERRY ROAD @ SACRAMENTO RIVER BRIDGE

Tehama County Department of Public Works seeks proposals for a one year contract to perform a constructability review, plan check, and specification review for Jellys Ferry Road @ Sacramento River Bridge Project. This Request for Proposal (RFP) solicits input from interested persons, corporations, or partnerships in assisting the County Public Works Department with reducing quantity overruns and potential change orders.

These services are federally funded and proposers must have a good understanding of the general requirements and project benchmarks associated with federal-aid projects such as Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) and federal lobbying restrictions; the DBE contract goal for this project is 0%.

The project is federally and state funded through MAP 21, the State Transportation Improvement Program, and the Local Safety Seismic Bridge Retrofit Program. The proposed project consists of replacement of the existing bridge with a new bridge approximately 1264 ft in length, construction of an overflow bridge approximately 685 ft in length, realignment of approximately 3300 ft of Jellys Ferry Road, and relocation of a portion of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) recreational facilities.
