

**TEHAMA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL & WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT  
AB3030 TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
MEETING MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 27, 2006**

Present: Jim Lowden; Bill Richardson; Bob Steinacher; Kevin Borrer; Roger Sherrill; Allan Fulton.

1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Lowden at 2:03 p.m. Chairman Lowden requested a motion to add November 21, 2006 minutes to the agenda. Motion by Roger Sherrill and second by Bob Steinacher to add the November 2006 minutes to the agenda for approval. Carried 6-0 with 3 absent.
2. Introductions of all present.
3. Approval of November 21, 2005 and January 23, 2006 Minutes: Motion by Kevin Borrer and second by Allan Fulton to approve the November 2005 and January 2006 minutes. Carried by those present 6-0 with 3 absent.
4. Public Comment: Kevin Borrer questioned the Del Webb project status. Ernie Ohlin answered the current information from the EIR is that the proposal is to draw potable water from the 200 to 500 ft. aquifer layer, and supplemental for the golf course would be from the 1000 ft level due to arsenic testing results.

Ernie Ohlin attended the NCWA meeting in which the Governor spoke on plans for bonds and levees. The speech is available on the web.

Roger Sherrill discussed SB820 which was vetoed by the Governor. Modification to the terminology will be done for submittal to the Governor.

Allan Fulton reviewed the Ag Waiver and monitoring delays due to weather.

5. Butte County BMO Data Center: An overview of the Butte County BMO Data Center was presented by Les Chau and Jerome Price. With the sorting and retrieval information the program is capable of, it would greatly enhance well information in Tehama County as well as other counties if shared.
6. SB1938 and BMO Discussion: CDM, John Ayers was absent. Ernie Ohlin discussed and distributed comments received regarding the BMO process. It was decided that the trigger levels would be set and/or defined by the AB3030 TAC, rather than an ADHOC committee.

Roger Sherrill felt this should remain under the jurisdiction of the Groundwater Management Program as defined in the Plan and approved by the public. If this is outside the Plan, we will need to modify the Plan.

7. Annual Report Discussion: Information for the report will be forwarded to the Chairman and discussed at the next meeting.
