TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES OF AUGUST 18, 2008

Present: Bill Richardson, Roger Sherrill; Jeff Wharton, Allan Fulton; Colin Klinesteker; Bob Steinacher. Absent: Steve Kimbrough, Mark Barthel; Charles Crain;. Also present: Ernie Ohlin, Deputy Director of Public Works-Water Resources; Bill Ehorn of DWR.

1. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Allan Fulton at 2:04 pm.
2. MINUTES: Motion by Roger Sherrill and second by Colin Klinesteker to approve the minutes of July 21, 2008. Carried 6-0 with 3 absent.
3. INTRODUCTIONS: Committee introductions where made..
4. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Ernie Ohlin discussed the DWR proposed Water Transfer Environmental Impact Report. Originally, it was thought that the document was a Programmatic document, however, DWR now states that it is intended to be project specific.

Allan Fulton discussed information on the Stony Creek Fan Project.

5. AB3030 GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN-DEVELOPMENT OF QUARTELY NEWLETTER Or PRESS RELEASE: Colin Klinesteker offered to bring back a draft for the committee's review at the next meeting. Colin stated that the Red Bluff Daily News would allow a 300 to 500 word article. . Bill Ehorn suggested distribution be in the Red Bluff Daily News, Corning Observer, email, over the counter and the District's web site. Colin suggested a limited number of mailings to primarily agriculture businesses.
6. GROUNDWATER "TRIGGER LEVEL" OUTREACH DISCUSSION OF OUTREACH PROCESS: Ernie Ohlin updated the members on the steps necessary for the program. Allan Fulton suggested holding the first outreach meeting in about three months, after harvest is completed, approximately mid- November. Allan Fulton spoke of developing a group of people to meet as a "Round Table" for the first outreach meeting, perhaps 10 to 15 agricultural producers throughout the county. Roger Sherrill suggested possibly holding two roundtable meetings to include others. Ernie Ohlin stated that the budget was \$5,400.00 for printing additional documents. To get the word out to as many people as possible with emphasis on purveyors and water users.. Bill Richardson stated that it was important to get enough copies of the Technical Memorandums for the sub-basin. Ernie Ohlin suggested inviting 2 or 3 water users in the community, Civic Groups, Cattlemen Association, Farm Bureau, Chamber of Commerce and the Tehama County Local Development Corporation.(TLDC).

7. REVIEW PAGES 40 THRU 47 OF THE AB3030 PLAN: Ernie distributed the document copies. The Advisory Committee reviewed pages 40 to 43. Comments are under separate cover.
