

TEHAMA COUNTY AB3030 TAC MEETING MINUTES OF MARCH 17, 2008

Present: Walt Mansell, Bill Richardson, Colin Klinesteker, Allan Fulton, Bob Steinacher, Steve Kimbrough and Roger Sherrill. Absent: Mark Barthel. Also present: Ernie Ohlin, Water Resources Manager; Bill Ehorn of DWR.

1. The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Allan Fulton at 2:04 pm.
2. Approval of Minutes: Motion by Walt Mansell to approve Items 1 through 6 of the minutes only.

Discussions of the review and revisions of Item 7 will not be approved.

Allan Fulton made a correction to Rawson changing to Paskenta for the data logger installation.

Motion seconded by Bill Richardson. Carried 6-0 with 2 absent.

3. Introductions: Bob Steinacher; Allan Fulton; Bill Richardson; Roger Sherrill; Colin Klinesteker; Bill Ehorn; and Walt Mansell.
4. Public Comment:

Walt Mansell discussed items in the Stockton Record regarding water issues, planning, Delta issues, loss of farm land to other development. An editorial regarding such as the propriety of people owning quality land in the Delta, laying their land fallow, and selling water to marginal farm land in Kern County.

Steve Kimbrough entered.

Bob Steinacher discussed his trip to Equador. Their water is pumped from a large river and people receive water by truck. Drinking water is bottled.

Bill Ehorn discussed the monitoring well to be installed northeast of the town of Nord. The right of way has been received and the environmental paperwork has begun. The 1200 ft. multi-completion 4-zone monitoring well is scheduled to begin April 14th.

Discussion of review of the last meeting minutes regarding GCID's Negative Declaration.

Ernie Ohlin updated the TAC on the subsidence monitoring project. The project begins at Shasta Lake and into Butte, Glenn and Colussa County. Training will be soon with the project beginning April 1st.

5. TAC Vacancy Application Results: Ernie Ohlin advertised for the opening in the TAC with one application received from Chuck Crain of Crain Mills. With the TAC recommendation, Staff will present the nomination on the Board agenda for approval.

A consensus was to provide the information to the Flood Control Board for approval.

6. Installation of Data Logger-Spanfelner Well: Allan Fulton discussed the installation problems with the well monitoring. Oil was found on the top of the well and will need to be cleared before the installation can be completed. The well is a 750 ft. gravel packed well and pump tested at 500 gallons.
