1. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. by Chairman Ryan Sale.
2. **Introductions:** No introductions required.
3. **Public Comment:** There was no public comment.
4. **Approval of February 2013 Minutes:** Motion by Dean Sherrill, second by Lyle Dawson, to approve the minutes of the February 25, 2103 meeting.
5. **Discussion: 2012 AB3030 Groundwater Management Plan and Ordinance Adopted May 14, 2013:** The AB3030 Groundwater Management Plan was adopted on May 14, 2013. The front portion of the plan is to serve as reference materials, with the appendices being updated as needed.
6. **Discussion: Glenn County Landowner Monitoring Guide:** The Glenn County Landowner Monitoring Guide was distributed to TAC members. Glenn County put this guide together with information provided by DWR. The information could be modified for Tehama County and distributed with sub-basin information.
7. **Discussion: Antelope Water Issues:** Seth Lawrence presented three hydrographs for wells in the Antelope area. Historically, groundwater levels in this region have been static. Areas along the Sacramento River have seen the most noticeable impact from the dam removal. Though water levels have increased, this increase is not reflected in shallow wells. The current 'spring high levels' are consistent with typical 'summer low' levels.

Wells located in the Gerber area, west of I-5 are showing a decline worse than wells in the Antelope area, though the domestic wells in this region are deeper. Land owners in this area should be encouraged to dig deeper wells when they install new wells.
